


TEST HISTORY IN PARENTVUE/STUDENTVUE


Test History has been added to ParentVUE and StudentVUE accounts. Hopefully this will assist schools with providing MAP and other test scores to parents, and will save the expense of mailing these scores home multiple times a year.

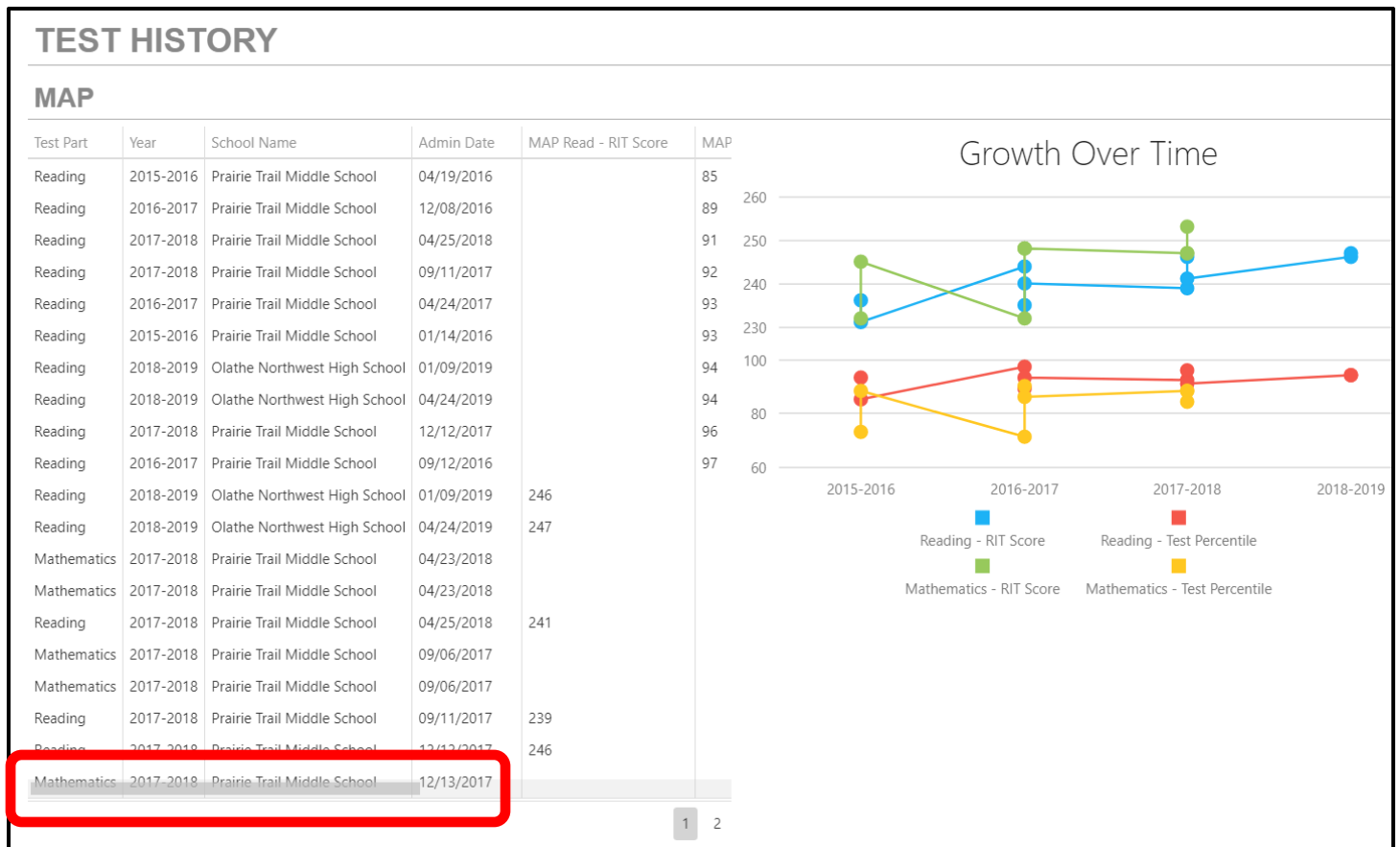

Note: It appears as though the Growth Over Time chart is blocking the view of Scores, especially when viewing MAP tests. However, if you hover over the bottom of the Test grid, you will see a scroll bar appear, and you can pull the score columns into full view! Students and Parents may also hover over the color coded “dots” on the Growth Chart to see scores.
