\$142,000

for student support and academic enrichment to provide students with access to a well-rounded education, safe and healthy learning environments, and technology

\$7.4 MILLION

for school meals to meet the basic needs of students so they are ready to learn

in Title I Grants to raise the academic achievement of all students, especially those from lower-income families



for multilingual education to help English learners achieve proficiency, and provide all students with opportunities to be multilingual

for career-connected learning to help students learn about career pathways, attain credentials needed for careers, participate in work-based learning opportunities, and transition to postsecondary education and jobs

\$494,000

for improving instruction to improve teaching, assist in recruiting and retaining educators to address educator shortages, and to reduce class sizes for more one-on-one attention
