Camp 1: Elementary school (incoming 2nd - 5th Grade) - This camp will be held at ODAC on the softball fields. The first hour of camp will consist of warming up, playing catch, followed by fundamental skill work in infield, outfield and hitting. The last hour each day will be dedicated to coach/machine pitch scrimmages where the campers will be split into teams based on age groups and can develop their skills.

Camp 2: Middle school (Incoming 6th - 8th grade) - This camp will be held at ODAC. The first hour of camp will consist of playing catch, followed by fundamental skill work in infield, outfield and hitting. The last hour each day will be dedicated to coach/machine pitch scrimmages where the campers will be split into teams based on age groups and can develop their skills.

Camp 3: High School (Incoming 9th - 12th grade) - This camp will be held at ODAC. This camp is for incoming 9th graders and returning students in high school. You do NOT need to be on the high school team to attend this camp. This is an opportunity to show your progress in the summer. For this camp we will split the campers into groups and scrimmage.

- **Rainout Policy:** NO additional days will be added to the camp if 1 day is canceled due to weather. If 2 days are canceled due to weather, the camp will be extended 1 day.

- **ALL PAYMENTS WILL BE COLLECTED AT CHECK-IN BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF CAMP. Payments must be either cash or check made out to Jeff Boyd.**
