STEP 1: REQUESTED CLASSES

Select **2.0 credits** of elective courses by placing an **X** in the **REQUEST** column.

Resource and QUEST credits count toward the 2.0 elective classes.

STEP 2: ALTERNATE CLASSES

Select at least **four** elective classes as alternate choices.

Alternate class selections may **NOT** be the same as requested classes.

Rank in order of preference: 1, 2, 3, 4 in the **ALT. CLASSES** column.

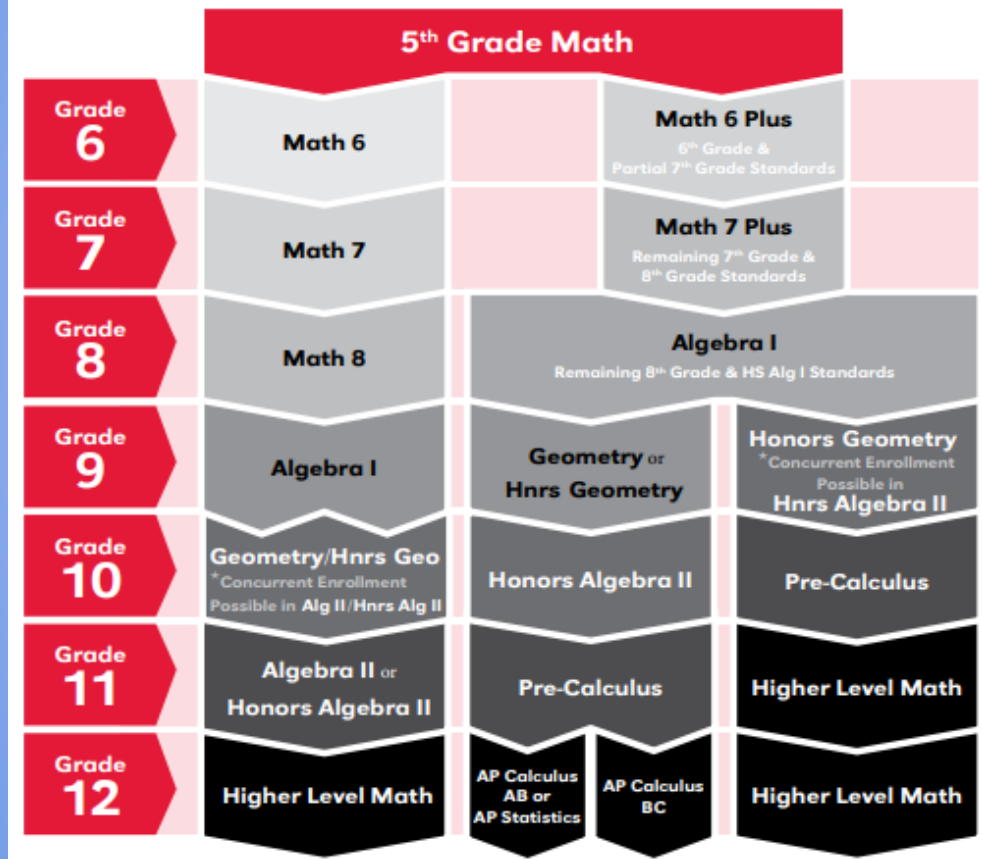

Secondary Math Course Sequence

New District Pilot Option



- Math 6 students received a letter last week from their current math teachers about this program.
- Math 6 students have the opportunity to advance to Math 7+.
- This opportunity is **ONLY** for current Math 6 students.

Elective Classes

7th Grade:

Students have not taken any of the classes listed on the enrollment form.

****For example,** if you took a QUARTER elective in 6th grade, like Art 6, you will take the “1” version, Art 1, in 7th grade. You did NOT have to take the quarter elective to sign up for a class!

8th Grade:

- Electives offered in 7th grade will be available again, if they have not already taken them. The only exception is Theatre II can be repeated, along with our music courses.
- In addition, the following are offered to 8th grade only:
 - Spanish I (year)
 - * now a HS credit
 - French I (year)
 - * now a HS credit
 - Yearbook (year)
 - Jazz Band (year)
 - Art III (semester)
