**ACADEMIC SUPPORT**

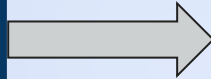
Students **must** have an IEP to enroll in Resource or QUEST.

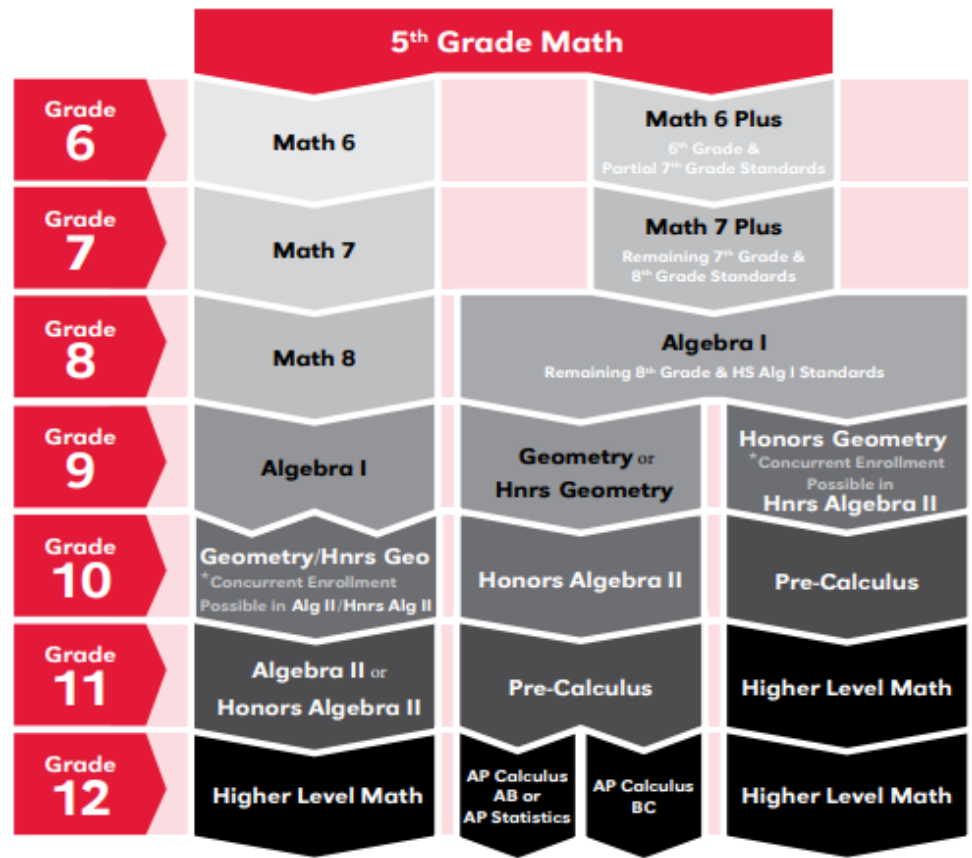
