





For Semester/Year Electives, please put an X in the REQUEST column if you want one or more. These electives take priority over Quarter Electives.

ACADEMIC SUPPORT

Students **must** have an IEP to enroll in Resource or QUEST.

These classes count towards the 1.5 elective credit total.



- This opportunity is ONLY for current Math 6 students.




