What is College Now?

College credit a student has the *OPPORTUNITY* to earn in a *high school class* with a *high school* teacher authorized by the community college to teach the curriculum

- College level textbooks
- College level curriculum
- Grade will be on BOTH the high school transcript and college transcript

- 1. Apply on-line as a JCCC student- http://admissions.jccc.edu
- 2. UPLOAD_ACT scores/transcript/AP score or take ACCUPLACER/ALEKS placement test as necessary. Upload on the JCCC website:

- 3. Enroll in the class & PAY for the credit hours
 - This step is taken care of with JCCC walk in/telephone/on-line
 - Deadline: 5:00PM on Monday, September 22nd
 - Cost is \$101 per credit hour

AP Calculus AB/BC

JCCC Precalculus grade > C or math ACT score > 28 or ALEKS placement test

Quick Step Plus College Algebra

<u>College Now Placement Information | Johnson County Community</u>

Prerequisites - must meet one of the below:

- ACT math score > 22
- ALEKS placement test score
- Unweighted high school GPA ≥ 3.25 AND B- or higher in final semester of Algebra 2
- Unweighted high school GPA > 3.25 AND ACT math score > 20
- Unweighted high school GPA >3.25 and ALEKS placement test score

Deadline to enroll and pay for College Algebra is Monday, eptember 22nd at **5:00PM**

AP Test Registration

- Create a College Board Account (only do this ONE time)
- Join AP Classroom for each AP class. –Join codes are provided by your AP teacher
- Choose the option of "yes" for taking the AP test
- Purchase the test (\$104) in TouchBase
- Tests will NOT be ordered for students who do not pay AND choose "yes" in AP Classroom by the deadline.

AP Test Registration

- Deadline is November 7th at 11:59 PM
 - Students enrolled in AP Gov in the spring as well as students taking Students taking the Physics C Electricity & Magnetism exam have a March 6th deadline. (Please note Physics C Mechanics has a November 7th deadline)
- Testing locations vary. Schedule with locations will be available at a later date and will be shared by teachers.
- Parents/students provide their own transportation.
- A partial refund of \$54 will be issued for late cancellations.
