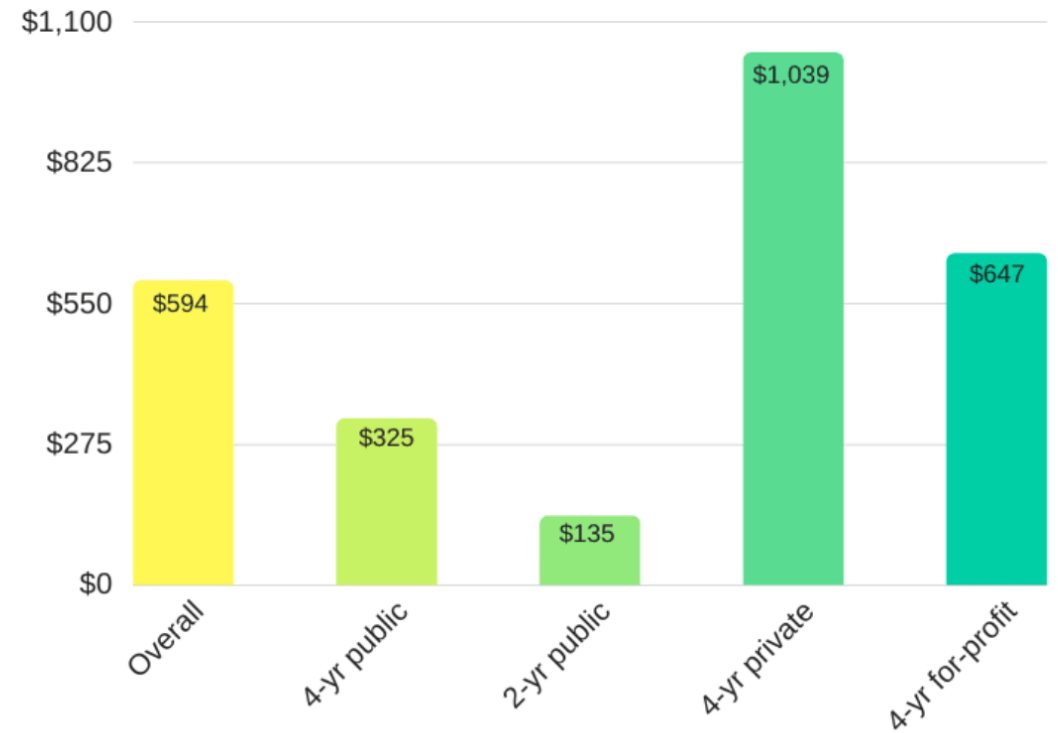

Four-year public university (in-state)	\$21,120	\$7,540	\$13,580
