- Registration is open!
- Registration ends Tuesday, November 6, 2023
 1-STUDENTS must log in to (or create) their College Board account at apstudents.collegeboard.org and join each AP Classroom (teachers have join codes). Then they need to choose "YES" or "NO" for each exam. All accounts will be marked as "NO" until the student changes it to "YES."

AP Exam Cost

- Each exam costs \$103.
- **No** exams will be ordered without registration and payment.
- Late registrations will have a \$40 late fee added after November 1. See Mrs. Carbajo if you are registering late.
- Students who qualify for *Free and Reduced Lunches* may take their AP exams for **FREE**.
- Students taking AP GOVERNMENT in the Spring will order and pay in the spring!!! Details to come later.
- Students that cancel their exam will be charged a \$40 cancellation fee per College Board.

On Test Day

AP Exams are held during the school day, and testing begins promptly at 8 am or 12 pm. Students are responsible for their own transportation to and from the exam site. Allow yourself time to park and check in. Please see the schedule for testing dates and times. Locations will be announced at a later date. Students are expected to be at school before and after testing times. Cell phones will **NOT** be allowed in the testing room during exams.
