Think Pair Share Let's discuss!

In-Person

- 1. T: (Think) Teachers begin by asking a specific question about the text.
- 2. Students "think" about what they know or have learned about the topic.
- 3. P: (Pair) Each student should be paired with another student or a small group.
- 4. S: (Share) Students share their thinking with their partner.

In-Person with Safety Measures (masks and social distancing)

- 1.T: (Think) Teachers begin by asking a specific question about the text.

- 4. S: (Share) Students share their thinking with their partner.

Online Learning
