21<sup>st</sup> Century students sometimes experience scheduling challenges due to the courses required in their program and courses required for graduation, and find they don't have room for electives and personal options they might want. eAcademy provides online courses that students take beyond the school day or in our summer program in order to provide flexibility in their classroom schedule.
