What are the eligibility requirements?

(1) Candidates for the Distinguished Person of Honor recognition must be current or former employees of the Olathe Public Schools; and (2) must have made a positive impact and/or great achievement in at least one of the following areas: personal and/or professional life; community/ humanitarian service; or commitment to educational excellence in the Olathe Public Schools.

How are honorees selected?

A committee of the Olathe Public Schools Alumni Association makes a recommendation to the alumni association board for final selection.

Is there a deadline?

March 1 is the deadline for the current year, but nominations are accepted on an ongoing basis throughout the year.

When did this project begin?

The first Distinguished Person of Honor was recognized in 2012.

Is there an actual wall?

Yes, plaques listing the honorees by year are on display in the lobby of the Education Center, 14160 Black Bob Road, Olathe, Kansas. In addition, we have a touch-screen computer kiosk showcasing each honoree's photo and biography.

Additional information:

Nominees will not be discriminated against on the basis of race, creed, religion, sex, nationality, disability, economic status or marital status. The award may be bestowed posthumously.
