## Reading — USD 233 Screening Measures

Assessment Name	Description
<b>FAST aReading™</b> Grades 2 – 8	Student completes 30-60 computer-based reading questions that are selected based on the student's grade and skill level. Includes questions related to all reading skill areas.
<b>FAST AUTOreading™</b> Grades 2 – 5	The student completes two, three, or four brief subtests that measure phonics, fluency, and/or vocabulary.
<b>FAST CBMreading™</b> Grades 1 – 5	Student reads out loud for one minute while the teacher records any errors.
<b>FAST earlyReading™</b> Grades preK – 1	Student completes three subtests that measure important beginning reading skills related to letter names and letter sounds, as well as reading words and/or short text.

Assessment Name	Description
<b>FAST aMath™</b> Grades 1 – 8	Student completes 30 computer-based math questions that are selected based on the student's grade and skill level. Includes questions related to all math skill areas.
<b>FAST CBMmath Automaticity™</b> Grades 1 – 8	Student answers computer-based math fact problems for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
<b>FAST earlyMath™</b> Grades preK – 1	Student completes 3 subtests that measure important beginning math skills related to numeral names, number sequences, and quantity discrimination.

Assessment Name	Description
<b>mySAEBRS™</b> Grades 2 – 12 (Parent consent required)	Students complete 20 computer-based questions related to their academic, emotional, and social skills.
<b>SAEBRS™</b> Grades K – 1 (Parent consent required)	Teachers complete 19 computer-based questions related to each student's academic, emotional, and social skills.
