Fees owed and items still in student possession

This is a reminder about the expectations associated with any financial obligations. It is important to note that an individual's diploma will not be distributed until all obligations have been satisfied. Any student who has a balance due for items such as registration fees, lost books (including library), athletic equipment, etc. from this year or any prior years, should make payments online using the district payment system – https://ks-olathe.intouchreceipting.com/.

Families with prior debt have already been notified through the District billing process. With 2020-21 year-end collections of materials, there may be additional notifications. The final notification will occur on Thursday, May 13th. Payment will be accepted until 3:30pm on Thursday, May 13th, no payments or return of items will be accepted until Monday, May 17th during office hours 7:30am to 3:30pm. Once the obligation is satisfied, the diploma will be released.

- If the weather forecast for graduation day looks as if it may adversely affect the plans for outdoor Graduation at CBAC, a decision by the district to move the graduation to the following Monday-Wednesday may be necessary. If a decision needs to be made regarding weather, **that decision will be made by 4:30pm on Saturday May 15** and notification (via email, text message as well as posted on the Olathe South and Olathe School District website) sent out at that time indicating that graduation has been moved to the following Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday.
- 6:00 p.m. Seniors report to the CBAC Soccer field.

7:00 p.m. Commencement begins at CBAC. Gates to the bleachers will open at 5:30 p.m. Parking may not be available until the Olathe North Ceremony is completed.
