Law Enforcement and Fire Rescue

WHO WE ARE:

Students in the Four-Year Public Safety Academy will gain the knowledge and skills necessary for post-secondary experiences in the professions of fire rescue or law enforcement. Students will learn specific content knowledge, hands-on skills, and employment skills which focus on team work, problem-solving, decision making, speaking and listening, and the necessary physical skills involved within the professions.

WHAT WE DO:

- Participate in self-defense and obstacle course training activities that are utilized by local law enforcement professionals
- Apply local, state, and federal laws to real-world law enforcement scenarios and evaluate their use in the pursuit of justice
- Learn how to document, process, photograph and analyze evidence from a crime scene

- Develop skills for effective communication with the Spanish speaking community during emergency response situations
- Explore fire department communications, fire ground operations, rescue operations, safety, preparedness, and maintenance
- Train for Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT) certification which is needed for employment in the fire rescue profession
