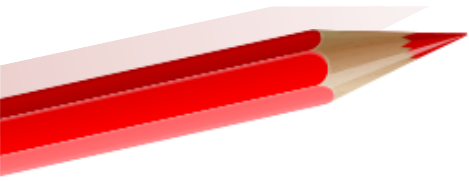

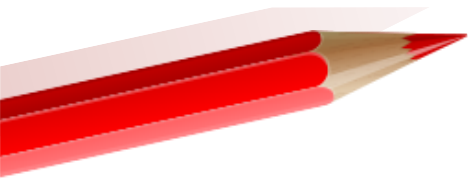

Work on:

- Learning to take turns; losing gracefully
- Being kind and patient
- Play board games, have play dates



3. Speaking & Listening

Work on:

- Communicating their needs
- Speaking in complete sentences
- Sitting and listening to a story and answering questions about the story
- Being able to follow multiple step directions



4. Social-Emotional

Work on:

- Explaining their feelings
- Self-regulation (calming strategies); breathing, singing a song, counting to 5
- Problem Solve (What can I do about this?)

Work on:

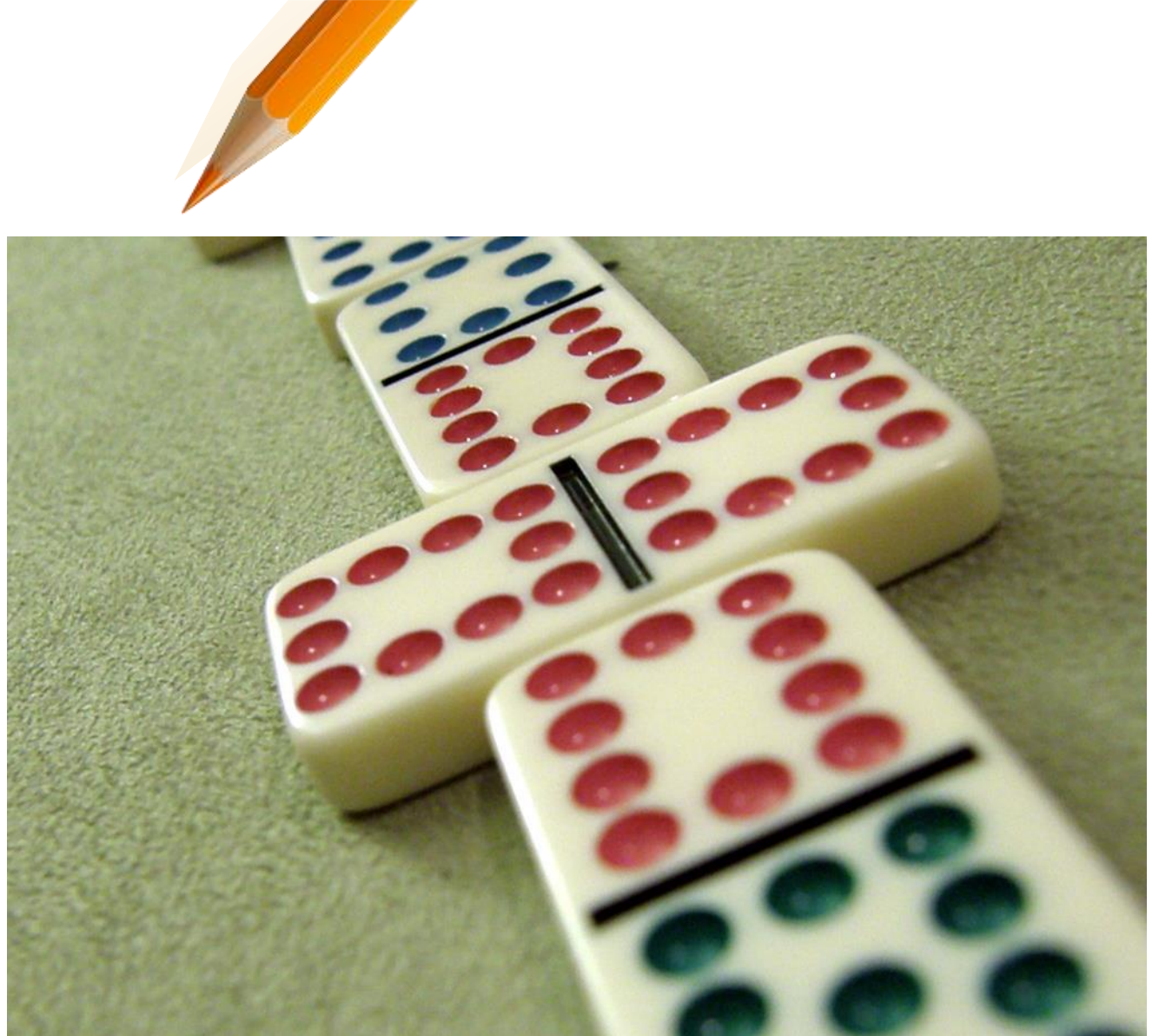
- Reading to your child nightly

Work on:

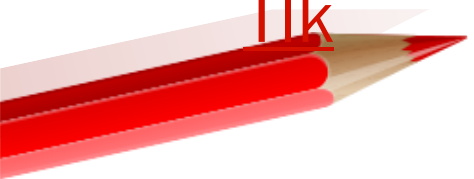
- Child writing their name (starting with a capital letter than lower case letters)
