- Teacher Loan Forgiveness for full-time teachers with five complete and consecutive years of teaching experience in a
 designated elementary or secondary school, or educational service agency that serves students from low income families.
- Public Service Loan Forgiveness (PSLF) public service employees who work full-time at a qualifying organization can have 100% of their student loans forgiven after 120 eligible on-time monthly payments.
- Income-Based Repayment Plans (IBR) ties what your monthly payment is to your discretionary income and
 forgives any leftover balance at the end of the repayment period.
