Free/Reduced Lunch application

Olathe Public Schools families,

We wanted to remind you that the federal funding support that has provided school breakfasts and lunches free to students for the past two years is coming to an end. With this in mind, please be advised of the following items.

- For the 2022-23 school year, families once again will pay full price for student breakfasts and lunches unless they apply and qualify for free-and-reduced meals through the district's application process.
- The new free and reduced application for 2022-23 is available at <https://frapps.horizonsolana.com/OLAS01>. Families must apply each year for free or reduced food service and student registration fees.
- Filling out the federal free and reduced application will be necessary before students will be able to qualify for and access free or reduced breakfast and lunches during the 2022-23 school year.

Cubby system

We have a “cubby system” for deliveries. Inside the main office vestibule there is a set of cubbies. You will leave the delivery in one of the empty cubbies, then you are to contact your student via text or email to let them know which cubby it is in. It is your student's responsibility to come pick it up at the teacher's convenience. Please always make sure the student's name is on the delivery.

Parking passes

Students who drive to school and park on district property (including CBAC) during the school day should have a parking permit. These are available on our Touchbase site for purchase. Parking passes are distributed through our Student Services (Counseling) office and can be picked up during the day from 7:30am to 3:30pm.

ATTENDANCE INFORMATION:

If your student is going to be absent, leave early, or come to school late, please call 913-780-7111. You can leave a message 24/7.

Select the option that applies to the attendance information you wish to communicate:

- PRESS 1: To report an all day absence
- PRESS 2: If your student will be late and you need to excuse their tardy
- PRESS 3: If your student needs a pass to leave during the school day
Please allow at least 30 minute notice for all passes to be issued
- PRESS 4: All other attendance information

If your student is arriving to school late, they need to show their photo ID (school ID, driver's license, or Student Vue) to the camera to be admitted. They will sign in at the attendance window and an electronic pass will be issued.

If your student is leaving the building, an e-Hallpass will be issued. This electronic pass will appear on the e-Hallpass dashboard for the student and their teacher. At the time of dismissal, your student will be released from class to go to the attendance window to pick up their pass. Once your student

has checked out at Attendance he/she is free to leave the building. You are always welcome to come into the office, but it is not necessary.

Senior Ads can be purchased in TouchBase, where you may have already preordered your 2023 Evermore. **Act quickly to take advantage of our early bird Senior Ad pricing until September 30th, 2022!** You may purchase an eight, fourth, half, or full page ad, which will include different photo and message limitations, as described below. **Please note that messages and photos must be submitted using the links below at the time of purchase on TouchBase, so all materials must be received by the Evermore staff before the early bird deadline to secure early bird pricing.** Senior Ads that have been purchased but not had their materials properly submitted before the early bird deadline are subject to full pricing.

Eighth page, no more than 35 words and 1 photo (portrait only)

Early bird price (*ends 9/30*): \$80

Regular price: \$100

Fourth page, no more than 35 words and up to 2 photos (portrait or landscape)

Early bird price (*ends 9/30*): \$130

Regular price: \$150

Half page, no more than 50 words and up to 5 photos (portrait or landscape)

Early bird price (*ends 9/30*): \$180

Regular price: \$200

Full page, no more than 75 words and up to 8 photos (portrait or landscape)

Early bird price (*ends 9/30*): \$275

Regular price: \$300

To purchase and submit materials for your Senior Ad, follow the steps below:

1. **PREPARE YOUR CONTENT:** Familiarize yourself with the Senior Ad size options, prices, deadlines, and submission guidelines. After choosing your Senior Ad size, start drafting a message to your senior that will accommodate the max word count. Be sure to include an appropriate signature (Love, Mom and Grandma). Additionally, gather the correct amount of photos you would like to use. Make sure these digital photos are properly sized and ready for uploading.
2. **PAY FOR YOUR SENIOR AD:** Purchase your Senior Ad on TouchBase at <https://ks-olathe.intouchrecepting.com/>
 - a. NOTE: Purchasing a Senior Ad does NOT secure a copy of the 2023 Evermore. Copies of the yearbook must be purchased separately, also in TouchBase.

This year, ONW will be participating in National Testing Day on Wednesday, October 12th, 2022. Although our freshmen, sophomore, and junior students will be automatically enrolled in a specific ACT test appropriate to their grade level, these students also have the option to register and pay for the PSAT test. Juniors taking the PSAT are considered for National Merit status and are eligible for scholarships based on the results of that assessment. Freshmen and Sophomores considering the PSAT in their Junior year are encouraged to take the PSAT as well as a practice for that exam in their junior year.

Wednesday, October 12th is a half day for students, and in lieu of classes, students will be participating in one of a few available assessments.

- **Freshmen** will be automatically enrolled in the Pre ACT 8/9 assessment but may choose to register and pay separately to take the PSAT.
- **Sophomores** will be automatically enrolled in a Pre ACT 10 assessment but also have the option to register and pay separately to take the PSAT.
- **Juniors** will also be automatically enrolled in a practice ACT (with no official score available). Juniors may decide instead register to take the Armed Forces Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) test or the PSAT. Juniors taking the PSAT will be considered for National Merit status.

PSAT Registration Directions:

For those students and families interested in the PSAT, there are a few important deadlines approaching:

1. Requests for accommodations for the PSAT must be submitted via the google form linked below no later than **5:00pm on Friday, August 19th**. Use the Google Form linked here (<https://forms.gle/ojNiZN7RcBB7bq466>) to request accommodations if your child plans to take the PSAT and has a 504 or IEP listing specific testing accommodations.

Please note, filling out this google form is not registration for the PSAT. *Please complete the steps below in addition to requesting accommodations.*

2. The deadline to sign up for the PSAT test is **11:59pm on Friday, September 2nd**. **Late registration for the PSAT is not available.**

To register for the PSAT, please follow the steps below:

- Parents, go to <https://ks-olathe.intouchrecepting.com/> and register to take the PSAT by midnight on Friday, September 2nd.
- They will click on the student who wants to take the PSAT, then click “Items at Student’s School.”
- They will click “PSAT”, then “Buy.”
- Proceed to checkout and enter payment information.
